The blocks can be used for:

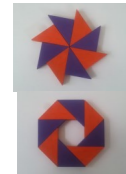
- Balancing and building which is great for fine motor skill development and creative play

In a group sharing and cooperation are part of the activity as is the pack up into the frame at the end

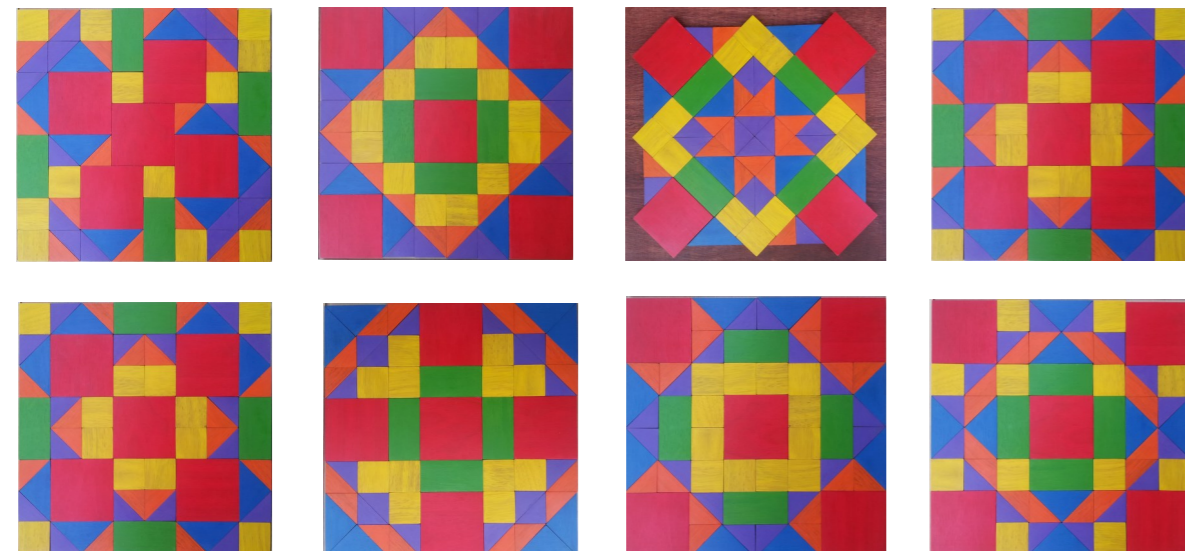
For everyone: Whatever you want. Maybe:

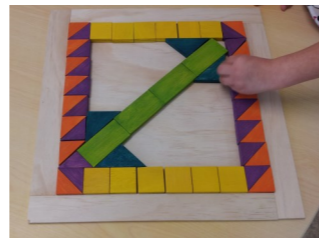

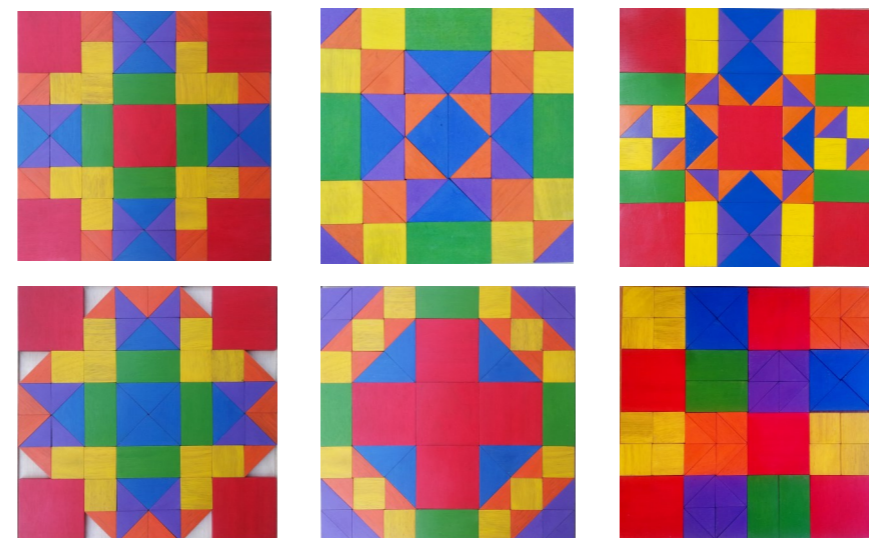
